

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO THE DULY QUALIFIED RESIDENT VOTERS OF EAST MONTGOMERY COUNTY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held on May 7, 2016, between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The purpose of the election is to elect directors to director position numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4 for the East Montgomery County Improvement District.

The presently existing boundaries and territory of the respective Montgomery County election precincts that are wholly or partially within the territorial boundaries of the District are hereby designated as the voting precincts of the District for the election. Pursuant to the provisions of the Joint Election Agreement with Montgomery County Elections Administrator, the following two locations have been designated as consolidated polling locations that will serve as the precinct voting locations for voters within the District: 1) Splendora ISD Instructional Support Services located at 26175 FM 2090, Splendora, Texas, 77372 (serving precincts 12, 16 and 41), and 2) East County Courthouse Annex, 21130 Highway 59 South, New Caney, Texas, 77357 (serving precincts 7, 14, 26, 37, 52, 53, 54, 64 and 82).

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the following seven (7) locations: 1) Election Central – 9159 Airport Road, Conroe, Texas 77303; 2) Lee G. Alworth Building – 207 West Phillips, Conroe, Texas 77301; 3) Magnolia Community Building – 422 Melton Street, Magnolia, Texas 77354; 4) City of Shenandoah Municipal Complex – 29955 I-45 North, Shenandoah, Texas 77381; 5) North Montgomery County Community Center – 600 Gerald Street, Willis, Texas 77378; 6) East County Courthouse Annex – 21130 U.S. Highway 59 South, New Caney, Texas 77357; and 7) Lone Star Community Center – 2500 Lone Star Parkway, Montgomery, Texas 77356. Early voting for the District shall occur between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on each weekday and Saturday that is not a county holiday beginning on April 25, 2016, and continuing through April 30, 2016. Early voting shall also occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on May 2, 2016, and May 3, 2016.

Except as otherwise allowed by law, applications for early voting ballot to be voted by mail shall be mailed to the Early Voting Clerk, Suzie Harvey, Montgomery County Elections Administrator, P.O. Box 2646, Conroe, Texas 77305-2646, or sent by email to Election.Ballot@mctx.org, and marked ballots to be voted by mail shall be returned by mail to the Early Voting Clerk, at the address listed above.
