

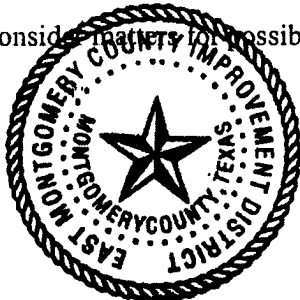
EAST MONTGOMERY COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

The Board shall consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Consider and act upon approval of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on June 10, 2021;
2. Consider engagement of auditor to prepare the Foundation's audit report for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
3. Consider proposals for the Foundation's insurance coverage (current term expires September 21, 2021);
4. Consider discussion regarding update on request to Internal Revenue Service;
5. Consider and take appropriate action related to financial and investment reports, including invoices and scholarship requests presented, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Consider discussion and approval of Pilot Program with the Mission and Lone Star College, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
7. Review and consider extending scholarship program to three-year application deadline from the current two-year deadline, and the taking of any actions in connection therewith;
8. Discuss structure and reorganization of Scholarship Foundation to provide opportunities for grant funding, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
9. Consider review and approval of merit-based scholarships;
10. Consider status of planning for Foundation banquet; and
11. Consider ~~tracting~~ possible placement on future agendas.
