As I mentioned before, if you're not following us on social media, you should. We post all kinds of things about our events, new businesses, old businesses, and status updates on projects. Check us out!

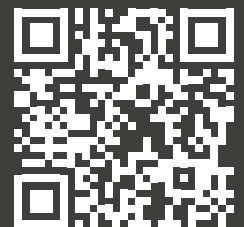

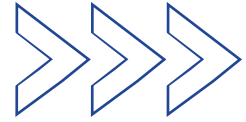
